Time-saving printing of documents in different formats

More and more documents are being stored electronically for a wide range of reasons, for example the need to share and re-use information, the increasing use of personal and product databases, legal obligations, historic relevance and many more. Documents are stored in standardised formats to prevent unauthorized alterations and ensure future accessibility.

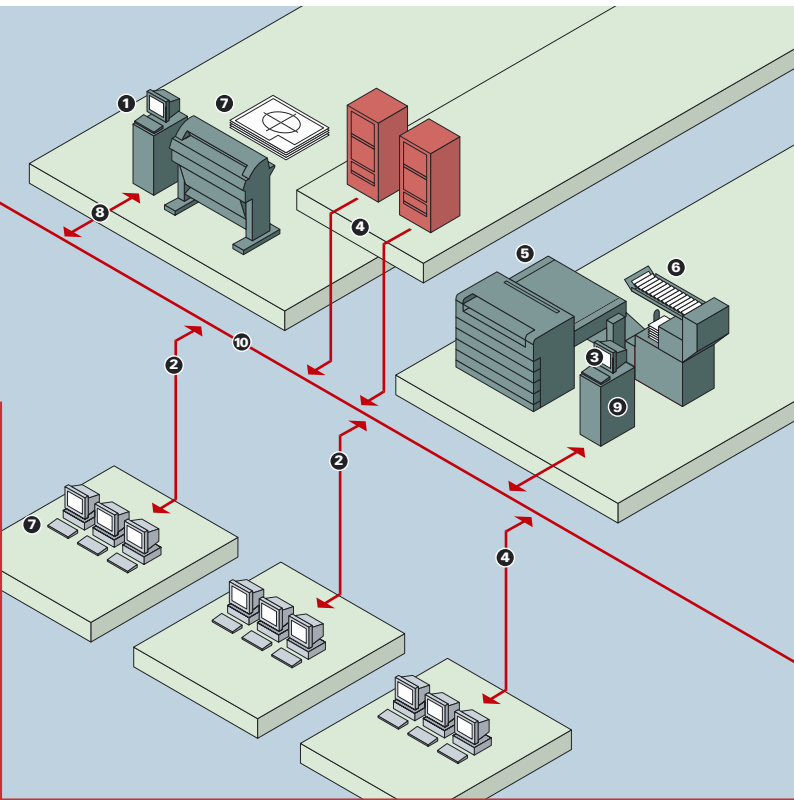
Examples of such formats are PDF, HP-GL/2 and TIFF, depending on the applications. Océ Print Exec Workgroup provides an efficient and time-saving way to access documents stored in different formats, to view, verify and select them, to build them into sets, and to print them.

Efficient selection of files for printing

With Océ Print Exec Workgroup, selecting the files you want to print is quick and easy. Whether they are located on your own system, on the network, among your scanned hard-copy files or in an Océ Doc Exec document archive, you can efficiently access all files from a single point of control. You can compose print jobs consisting of many files with multiple file selection or drag&drop, saving you time.

File previewing allows at-a-glance file verification, as well as giving an accurate impression of how each file will appear when printed.

If certain document sets are printed regularly, you can store them, together with the associated settings for future retrieval and re-use. When storing jobs, one has the possibility storing references to the included files, which keeps the job up to date when the files' content is changed

Easy print job configuration

For easy print job configuration, Océ Print Exec Workgroup supports all device features. You have on-line access to all printer functions and to settings at job and document level. Feedback of potential errors avoids mismatches between job settings and printer configurations, eliminating one of the most common sources of print interruptions and failures.

Time is saved during job preparation by automatic file format recognition. Specific, format-related settings are always available and are modified automatically if required; for example pen settings for HPGL files. If files have been saved with defined print settings, the job ticket is automatically decoded and the settings displayed.

And there's no need to re-enter frequently used job settings, because previously set configurations can be saved and retrieved instantly whenever you want to re-use them.

Job submission with automated verification

Underlining the efficiency gains that Océ Print Exec Workgroup offers, all print jobs are automatically verified before submission and warnings issued of potential errors. For example selection of media that are not loaded, or a file format that is not installed.

Print jobs are submitted in background mode, quickly returning Océ Print Exec Workgroup for use, so you can compose new print jobs while the last jobs are being submitted. Jobs for which submission fails for any reason, for example network errors, are automatically retried in the background until successful.

On-line information about job and device status

Once jobs have been submitted, you can constantly follow their progress from within Océ Print Exec Workgroup. So you can see instantly if any error has occurred, or you can monitor job status in the print queue at any time.

There's no need to walk up to the printer to see if a specific job is ready. Nor are jobs held up while waiting for user intervention, because this is clearly shown in the status indication. And if you ever have any doubt about what to do, extensive on-line help is always instantly available.

Efficient handling of physical documents

Océ Print Exec Workgroup is more than just an efficient job submission tool. It also provides you with powerful, time-saving support for handling your flow of physical documents. For example by allowing you to insert banner pages, or to add user-definable stamps, making it easy to identify specific documents, sets or complete print jobs.

These measures also help you to keep track of successive document versions and revisions. And in many cases they are essential to comply with quality procedures, for example as defined under ISO9000 and other QA programmes.



Easy deployment and web-based upgrading

Because it is pre-installed on the controller, Océ Print Exec Workgroup is quickly and easily deployed after activation. Besides, no additional server hardware is needed. Installation is initiated simply by selecting the printer URL using your standard web browser. Deployment to all connected workstations will then take place automatically.

Upgrading is just as easy, simply by selecting the upgrade package from the Océ Print Exec Workgroup administration page. The upgrade is then installed automatically on all connected workstations. If for any reason the previous version of Océ Print Exec Workgroup has to be restored, the roll-back feature does this automatically.

A cost-effective, future-proof investment

Océ Print Exec Workgroup is a highly cost-effective investment. Not only because of the increased efficiency that it brings to your printing process, but also because of its economic floating licensing, with a single license allowing concurrent use of the application.
